Walk/Golf for Warmth funds are used to provide assistance to families and senior citizens in emergency situations in fear of having their heat turned off in the cold winter months when other assistance is not available.

Funds raised were split with the **Dolly Parton Imagination Library** program which FiveCAP sponsors in Manistee, Mason and Lake counties. The program provides a book each month for enrolled children ages 0-5, until they are age 5. Every \$25 raised provides a book each month for a year to a child.

Qualified teachers use a research-based curriculum to prepare children for kindergarten with fun play activities and lessons.

Social and emotional growth are important components of the program, as well as physical skills, language and communication, math, phonics, social studies, science and technology.

Enrollment open to eligible residents with household income at or below 130% of the federal poverty level, homeless, and categorically eligible SNAP recipients.

Toys for Tots/Gifts for Teens is a partnership with Synergy Broadcasting. Children ages 0 to 18 residing in Mason and Manistee counties are eligible. At distribution, parents are able to choose from a wide range of age-appropriate gifts.

Starting November 1st, parents/guardians can apply at their county FiveCAP Office in Scottville or Manistee to get on Santa's list.

Distributions will be held Wednesday, December 13 and Thursday, December 14 at the Graystone Event Center adjoining the Holiday Inn Express in Ludington and at the VFW Center in Manistee.

Work can include air sealing, such as installing weather strips on doors, caulking, trim installation, patching holes in walls, and/or replacing windows and doors.

Household income must be at or below 200% of the federal poverty level. **Contact your FiveCAP county office to apply.**
