51st ANNUAL TOYS FOR TOTS / GIFTS FOR TEENS BRINGS THE JOY OF GIVING

The 2023 annual Toys for Tots/Gifts for Teens distribution was held December 13th and 14th at the Greystone Event Center in Ludington and the VFW Walsh Post 4499 in Manistee. Once again, FiveCAP, Inc. partnered with Synergy Broadcasting Group to collect toys, gifts and cash donations to purchase toys for area children ages 0-18 years old.

Thanks to the generosity of the Mason and Manistee communities, 632 area children re-

ceived presents on Christmas morning. In Mason County, 122 families participated in the program with toys and gifts for 324 children. In Manistee County, 119 fami-

lies participated in Toys for Tots/Gifts for Teens and 308 children had presents under the tree.

In the weeks leading up to distribution,, FiveCAP Executive Director Mary Trucks said she and the FiveCAP staff were inspired by the generosity of the community. "Each year, it's really heartwarming to see how people give to the program. It truly helps these parents make happy memories with their children."

On Friday, December 8th, Trucks and several FiveCAP staff members were presented a \$4000.00 check donation from the Ludington Meijer, which they used in addition to other monetary donations received to shop around the store for the event. 95 donation barrels placed around the area were also filled with gifts to be distributed.

"These contributions are just to name a few," said Trucks. "And we certainly cannot forget to thank our volunteers that helped pick up the toys from area businesses and distribution."

From this abundant selection, parents were able to select age-appropriate toys/gifts, stocking stuffers, and a family game for their children.

A big **THANK YOU** to the Greystone Event Center and the VFW Walsh Post 4499 for their annual support and donation of space for the distribution.




VFW Gold Bar Post #5096 Donates FIVE Complete Thanksgiving Meals

Free Tax Preparation for low-income residents



Trained FiveCAP staff will be making **appointments starting February 1st** to assist low-income residents in preparing and e-filing Federal and State income taxes. We help to ensure that eligible residents receive tax credits such as the Home Heating Credit, Homestead Property Tax/Rent Credit, and Child Tax Credit. *This service is free!!*

Contact your local FiveCAP Community Support Services Worker to schedule an appointment. You must provide your year-end tax documents (Social Security Benefit Statements, W-2(s), Child Support Statements, Unemployment 1099G, etc.).

FiveCAP is accepting Weatherization Program applications in Mason, Lake and Newaygo counties

FiveCAP is accepting applications for home weatherization. Funded by the U.S. Department of Energy, there are no costs for this service for households at or below the 200 percent Federal Poverty Level, and is available to home owners and rental units. This service is provided year-round in Mason, Lake and Newaygo counties.

Annual Walk for Warmth Events Saturday, February 17, 2024

Walk for Warmth is a locally funded program designed to raise money on a community level to assist local residents with winter heating expenses in *emergency* situations. The funds assist low-income families and senior citizens that may be just over the threshold of eligibility for other FiveCAP programs or public assistance...or when government program funds are delayed or unavailable.

Walk for Warmth events will be held in Mason, Manistee, Lake and Newaygo counties with a two mile walk on Saturday, February 17th starting at 10:00 a.m.
